When the Notice of Intent has been deemed complete by the Agency, another notice with a more detailed project description will be provided to you, and you will have another opportunity to provide written comment relevant to the Agency's review.

This public notice is being sent to adjoining landowners to the project site to the extent they were identified in the Notice of Intent; the Chairman of the County Planning Board, Chairman of the Regional Planning Board, if any; the chief elected officer, clerk and planning board chairman, if any, of the town or village where the project is located; and the Adirondack Park Local Government Review Board.

It is not necessary to respond to this notice unless you want to do so. If you wish to provide written comments, mail them to **Ariel Lynch**, the assigned APA Environmental Program Specialist 2 (EPS2), and reference the above project number.

PROJECT SPONSOR, LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION

The Agency received a Notice of Intent from the **NYSDOT**, **Crown Communications NY**, **Inc** & Verizon Wireless for a project located on or near **US Route 9** in the Town of **North Hudson**, **Essex** County, in an area designated as **State Administrative** on the Adirondack Park Land Use and Development Plan Map. The tax map number of the project site is: Section **95.1**, Block **1**, Parcel(s) **10**. The attached map shows the approximate location of the project site. The Agency is currently reviewing the application for completeness.

The project is briefly described as follows: Installation of a temporary "cell on wheels" at an existing NYS Department of Transportation maintenance yard from 12/1/22 to 2/7/23, during the World University Games. The proposed "cell on wheels" consists of a truck with a telescoping tower, to support Verizon Wireless antennas at 60 feet above ground level.





3.0 Detailed Project Description:

a. Description Of The Type Of Service And Facilities To Be Provided

The Project consists of the temporary installation of a "cell on wheels", also known as a "COW" from December 1, 2022 until February 7, 2023 in an existing vacant and cleared area at the existing NYSDOT Maintenance Yard at 4907 US Route 9, Town of North Hudson, Essex County, NY. The COW will support wireless telecommunications antennas of Verizon Wireless to provide Verizon Wireless commercial wireless telecommunications service to the travelling public and emergency service providers during the Winter World Games in Lake Placid, NY.

b. Description Of The Size Of The Overall Franchise Area Within The Adirondack Park Licensed By The Federal Communications Commission (FCC).

Not applicable.

c. Justification For Installation Of Service Equipment At This Site.

There are no other tall structures in the vicinity of the site that can physically support Verizon Wireless' antennas. Further, the proposed COW is temporary and will be located in an already disturbed vacant area of the existing NYSDOT Maintenance Yard which has existing access and utilities. As such, the Project will not give rise to any permanent physical land disturbance or potential environmental impact in the area.

4.0 FCC Licensed Service Area Map:

Verizon Wireless holds an FCC license to provide wireless telecommunications services throughout the Adirondack Park. Maps of Verizon Wireless's FCC license areas are on file with the APA.

a. Describe to what extent existing roads will be used to access the site

The proposed site is an existing NYSDOT Maintenance Yard with an existing driveway along US Route 9 which will be used for access to the proposed COW.

b. Describe the location, type of material, and size of any proposed temporary and/or permanent access drives to the project site.

No temporary or permanent access driveway is proposed.

c. Describe any proposed temporary or permanent improvements, including any proposed vegetation removal, site drainage, crossing of streams or wetlands and installation of impervious, paved surfaces and utilities.

Temporary utilities will be routed in conduit routed on the ground from the COW to the existing flagpole and then up the flagpole and overhead to the existing building where such utilities will connect to the existing utility source at the NYSDOT Maintenance Yard as illustrated in the Site Plans at <u>Attachment "A"</u>. No other temporary or permanent improvements are proposed or required to support the temporary installation of the COW.

d. Describe any proposed temporary or permanent erosion control.

None.

<u>8.0 Tower, Antenna and Infrastructure Description:</u>

a. Description and elevation of the tower, antennas and support facilities.

The proposed Temporary COW will consist of a truck with a 60-foot telescoping pneumatic mast, topped with an 8-foot mounting mast to support three (3) Verizon Wireless' panel antennas. The base of the mast that is supported by the truck will be 2 feet above ground level (AGL), to the overall height of the facility will be 70 feet AGL. Verizon Wireless' antennas will be mounted at a 66-foot centerline level AGL on the mounting mast. The tops of Verizon Wireless' antennas will be at the 68-foot level of the mounting mast, just below the guy anchor point on the mast.

b. Dimensions of Components and Associated Infrastructure.

1. <u>Temporary COW:</u> The dimensions and details of the COW are set forth on <u>Attachment "B".</u>

2. <u>Antennas:</u> The make, model and dimensions of each of the three (3) panel antenna (one per each of three sectors) to be mounted on the COW is set forth in the

manufacturer's specification sheet attached at <u>Attachment "C".</u> The antennas will be mounted at a centerline height of 66-feet AGL on the mounting 8-foot mast to be attached to the COW's pneumatic telescoping 60-foot mast.

3. The proposed Temporary COW does not require FCC registration and no Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") Form 7460-1 is required to be submitted because the tower is less than 200 feet in height and otherwise does not meet any threshold for filing a FAA Form 7460-1 due to airport proximity pursuant to 14 CFR §77.9, which is confirmed in the FAA evaluation at <u>Attachment "D"</u>. As such, no lighting or striping is required for this tower.

4. No equipment shelter is proposed. All related ground equipment will be within the COW.

9.0 Proposed Buildings and Structures:

No accessory buildings are proposed.

<u>10.0 Other Regulatory Permits and Approvals:</u>

A. NYSDOT issued a Highway Work Permit for this Project, a copy of which is attached hereto as <u>Attachment "E"</u>.

B. & C. The Project is immune from local land use regulation because it is a State Project and Verizon Wireless' proposed COW and antennas are embraced by the State's immunity pursuant to <u>Crown Communication New York, Inc. v. New York State Department of</u> <u>Transportation</u> (4 NY3d 159 [2005]). As such, a Local Government Notice Form and local jurisdiction are inapplicable to this Project.

D. Not applicable.

E. An FAA Form 7460-1 is not required for the proposed Temporary COW because it will be less than 200 feet in height and otherwise does not meet any threshold for filing a FAA Form 7460-1 due to airport proximity pursuant to 14 CFR §77.9, which is confirmed in the FAA evaluation at <u>Attachment "D"</u>.

F. The overall height of the Temporary COW will not exceed 85 feet, so consultation with the New York Air National Guard is not required

D. Verizon Wireless currently lack coverage in the area of Northway Exit 30 to temporarily be served by the proposed COW.

15.0 Project Benefits:

Verizon Wireless currently lacks wireless telecommunications service in the vicinity of the proposed Site. The New York State Police alerted Verizon Wireless that a significant, temporary increase in traffic in the area would occur during the Winter World Games and that wireless telecommunications service in the area during such period would improve public safety communications by the travelling public and emergency service providers. 
18.0 Discontinuance of Use:


